

## Tracking prices for the most essential goods available on the Lebanese market





November 2024

#### **ABOUT THIS REPORT**

This report is the result of a joint project between the Ministry of Economy and Trade (MoET) and the World Food Programme (WFP). The project aims to implement a market price information system and economic analysis in Lebanon, with the goal of enhancing the Ministry's capacity to monitor prices in the current context of economic volatility and insecurity.

The report is composed of three main sections:

- A high-level view of the latest price trends through the lens of the Market Food Price Index (MFPI)
- An **in-depth analysis** per food category and governorate
- An **annex table** displaying the latest prices nationally and per governorate

This report was based on price monitoring data of 74 food and non-food items from a representative sample of around 1,000 shops located across the eight governorates.

Data is collected weekly and stored on a price monitoring system hosted by WFP.

Due to the conflict ongoing at the time of data collection, November 2024 prices in the Nabatieh governorate were limited to a one-time price data collection across 25 shops. As data for vegetables and fruits were unavailable specifically in this governorate, their indexes for November 2024 were estimated by applying the monthly variation in national prices to the October 2024 prices in the governorate.

As for the South governorate, data collection primarily covered the Saida and Jezzine districts, as few markets were operational in the Sour district in November 2024.

#### **MARKET FOOD PRICE INDEX (MFPI)**

#### **Key highlights**

The MFPI reached **131.9** in November 2024, registering a **1.1 percent monthly decrease**, with a 12.5 percent decrease in fresh poultry, a 13.2 percent decrease in eggs, and a 6.4 percent decrease in fruits offsetting a 5.2 percent increase in vegetables and tubers. The MFPI has increased by **10.6 percent** since last year.

The price index has been driven since January 2023 by an index evolution in **vegetables and tubers** (181.7), **cereals** (125.3), and **fruits** (206.2).

The highest MFPI was observed in the governorates of **Beirut** (138.8) and **North** (136.3).

#### **KEY DRIVERS**

Larger urban areas and floods affecting local crop agriculture in January 2024 resulted in a more accentuated yearly price index evolution in Beirut and North Lebanon

Ongoing hostilities in Southern Lebanon and higher demand from internal displacement resulted in a notable monthly price index evolution in the governorates of South and Beirut. The poultry sector was particularly impacted by the deteriorating situation.



#### MFPI Evolution (Jan 23 - Nov 24)




The Market Food Price Index (MFPI) is a measure of the average change over time in the prices in US dollars paid by consumers for 64 essential food items. It is calculated as the weighted average of price changes for each of its components. The base month of the index is January 2023.


#### **ANALYSIS**

#### **Overview**

The slight monthly decrease in the national MFPI was due to market prices adjusting to the conflict setting and supply chain constraints in November 2024 while consumer habits hinted at a return to preconflict consumption of fresh vegetables and tubers. The effect of hostilities was particularly felt in the South governorate (+3 percent monthly evolution), while the Baalbek-El Hermel index registered an adjustment (-5 percent monthly evolution) following a sudden 7 percent increase registered last month. The fresh poultry and egg sectors were particularly affected by hostilities with dropping local consumption amid mass displacement despite stable local production leading to significant decreases in prices.



#### Market Food Price Index by Governorate (November 2024) Base = January 2023




#### **Notable Trends:**


- Each governorate had notable price evolutions in different components:
  - Akkar: Notable 5 percent monthly decrease in dairy compared to stability of prices at national level. Highest monthly decrease in eggs (-28 percent)
  - **Baalbek-El Hermel**: Highest yearly increase in condiments (+24 percent), and dairy (+20 percent). Highest monthly decrease in fruits (-36 percent).
  - **Beirut**: Notable 3 percent monthly increase in fresh poultry compared to a 13 percent monthly decrease at national level. Highest yearly increase in fruits (+42 percent).
  - Bekaa: Second highest monthly decrease in eggs (-24 percent)
  - Mount Lebanon: Highest monthly decrease in fresh poultry (-17 percent).
  - Nabatieh: Significant monthly and yearly increase in canned fish (+30 percent and +34 percent, respectively), compared to a 1 percent monthly and 9 percent yearly increase at the national level. Highest monthly decrease in sugar (-5 percent).
  - North: Highest monthly increase in condiments (+3 percent). Highest yearly increase in cereals (+14 percent).
  - **South**: Highest monthly increase in beverages (+3 percent), cereals (+3 percent), dairy (+3 percent), pulses (+4 percent), and vegetables and tubers (+15 percent). Highest yearly increase in beverages (+19 percent) and pulses (+27 percent). Notable 4 percent monthly increase in sugar compared to 1 percent decrease at national level.


#### MFPI Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




#### MFPI Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Component - National






## Canned Fish - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Cereals - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Condiments - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Dairy - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Eggs - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate


## Fresh Poultry - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Fruits - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Pulses - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate
