ABOUT THIS REPORT

This report is the result of a joint project between the Ministry of Economy and Trade (MoET) and the World Food Programme (WFP). The project aims to implement a market price information system and economic analysis in Lebanon, with the goal of enhancing the Ministry's capacity to monitor prices in the current context of economic volatility and insecurity.

The report is composed of three main sections:

- A high-level view of the latest price trends through the lens of the **Market** Food Price Index (MFPI)
- An in-depth analysis per food category and governorate
- An **annex table** displaying the latest prices nationally and per governorate

This report was based on price monitoring data of 74 food and non-food items from a representative sample of around 1,000 shops located across the eight governorates.

Data is collected weekly and stored on a price monitoring system hosted by WFP.

Due to the ongoing security concerns at the time of data collection, December 2024 prices in the Nabatieh governorate were limited to a one-time price data collection across 25 shops. As data for vegetables and fruits were unavailable specifically in this governorate, their indexes for December 2024 were estimated by applying the monthly variation in national prices to the November 2024 prices in the governorate.

As for the South governorate, data collection primarily covered the Saida and Jezzine districts, as few markets were fully operational in the Sour district in December 2024.

MARKET FOOD PRICE INDEX (MFPI)

Key highlights

The MFPI reached **135.7** in December 2024, registering a **2.8 percent monthly increase**, driven by a 16 percent monthly increase in **fresh poultry** and a 6 percent increase **in vegetables and tubers**. The MFPI has increased by **9.7 percent** since December 2023.

The price index has been driven since January 2023 by an index evolution in **vegetables and tubers** (192.9), **cereals** (124.2), **fruits** (212.6), and **fresh poultry** (134.4).

The highest MFPI was observed in the governorates of **Beirut** (140.3) and North (139.9).

KEY DRIVERS

The impact of **conflict escalation** and **deterioration of local food production** (mainly vegetables, fruits and fresh poultry) led to higher monthly inflation in Akkar and Baalbek-El Hermel.

The combined effect of conflict, mass displacement, and economic deterioration over the past year had a comparatively more pronounced impact on prices in Baalbek-El Hermel, North and South governorates.



The **Market Food Price Index (MFPI)** is a measure of the average change over time in the prices in US dollars paid by consumers for 64 essential food items. It is calculated as the weighted average of price changes for each of its components. The base month of the index is January 2023.


MFPI Evolution (Jan 23 - Dec 24)




ANALYSIS

Overview

Prices in December 2024 continued adjusting to the fluid security situation, with sharper price increases in northern Lebanon and the Bekaa Valley, as well as the South governorate. El Nabatieh governorate is the only governorate reporting a monthly decrease in prices, a result of continued challenges regarding internal displacement, shop operationality and post-ceasefire price adjustments. Prices of fresh poultry started recovering after dropping over the three previous months, as consumption of fresh products picked up again following the ceasefire.




Market Food Price Index by Governorate (December 2024) Base = January 2023




Notable Trends:

- Each governorate had notable price evolutions in different components:
 - **Akkar**: Highest monthly increase in beverages (+5 percent), dairy (+5 percent), eggs (+5 percent), fats and oils (+10 percent), and vegetables and tubers (+19 percent). Highest yearly increase in beverages (+21 percent).
 - **Baalbek-El Hermel**: Highest monthly increase in fruits (+40 percent), and second highest increase in vegetables and tubers (+16 percent). Highest yearly increase in dairy (+17 percent) and fresh poultry (+27 percent).
 - **Beirut**: Notable 17 percent monthly decrease in fruits, compared to 3 percent monthly increase at national level. Highest yearly increase in vegetables and tubers (+27 percent).
 - Bekaa: Notable 27 percent monthly increase in fresh poultry and 10 percent monthly increase in fruits.
 - El Nabatieh: Notable 8 percent monthly decrease in cereals; 20 percent monthly decrease in eggs and 13 percent monthly decrease in sugar.
 - Mount Lebanon: Lowest monthly increase in vegetables and tubers (+5 percent) alongside North governorate.
 - North: Notable 21 percent monthly increase in fresh poultry and lowest monthly increase in vegetables and tubers (+5 percent) alongside Mount Lebanon governorate.
 - South: Highest monthly increase in fresh poultry (+35 percent).

MFPI Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Component - National






Canned Fish - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Cereals - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Condiments - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate



Dairy - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate





Eggs - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate





Fats & Oils - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate







Fruits - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate




Pulses - Monthly & Yearly Price Evolution By Governorate
